Both companies want to continue and further accelerate their strong growth trajectory of recent years together. By combining the quality and coverage of their sales and service network, they want to take their service offering to the next level to the benefit of their customers, suppliers and employees.

In April, Hillewaert welcomed Sofindev as a strategic partner to support its strong position and growth in the professional coffee machine market in the Benelux. The combination of Hillewaert and ESD in Coffee Service Group (CSG) is an important further step in this development, with the full support of Sofindev.

This will make CSG an undisputed market leader in the Benelux, with international growth ambitions, in the sale and maintenance of professional coffee machines.

They will all remain responsible for the day-to-day management. With Sofindev, a reliable and strong partner is also on board, offering both financial and strategic support for growth and further international development. The focus will remain on innovation and reliable technical service for the out-of-home coffee market, such as the hospitality sectors, offices, (hotel) chains, airports and hospitals. CSG will become the 'one-stop-shop' for machines and service, with outstanding support aimed at continuously guaranteeing an optimal coffee experience.







ESD and Hillewaert already worked closely together in recent years in the distribution of the premium brand Franke, a manufacturer of high-quality and smart fully automatic coffee machines, and its own fully automatic espresso machine brand, Yunio, for smaller offices and catering businesses. In addition, both companies share a similar vision and corporate culture.



With more than 130 employees, 5 branches of which 2 in the Netherlands (Zeewolde and Purmerend) and 3 in Belgium (Knokke-Heist, Hasselt and Antwerp), and with premium brands such as Franke, Faema, Astoria and Yunio, the new CSG aspires to be and remain the leading supplier of coffee machines and service. In doing so, continuous innovation and 24h personal service are essential.

With this partnership, CSG also aims to further strengthen its position in the Dutch market, by providing suppliers with even greater market coverage throughout the Netherlands and by offering customers in the out-of-home coffee market an even wider range of quality and service. ESD's expertise in water systems will also be rolled out in the Benelux. More and more companies and families want to replace bottled water for ecological reasons. The partnership will also create additional opportunities for the employees of both companies.

In 1993, Peter Veerkamp founded ESD and started selling and servicing professional coffee machines. Soon after, Nico Klinkenberg also joined the company, who had gained prior experience in the coffee and service industry.

Over the years, ESD became part of Verdi Koffie Groep, a true family business with more than 60 employees, from technicians, planners, drivers, warehouse staff, internal and external sales teams to the finance and marketing departments. From a central office in Purmerend, North Holland, local customers and large (hotel) chains, caterers and wholesalers are supplied with machines and service. The company realized a turnover of €14 million in 2023.
